



State of Georgia Methamphetamine Container Program





CUSTOMER RELATIONSHIP MANAGEMENT (CRM)


Project Description - The CRM Application Project will provide a single source of historical interaction with external customers and will provide GCIC end users the ability to search, track and report customer interactions throughout business units.


Monthly Update - The project team is working on individual parts of the application that require special detailed attention and testing for incorporation into the final CRM database.


CUSTOMER SUPPORT & TRAINING

Project Description - The Customer Support Training group provides training in GCIC programs, GCIC applications, and GCIC/FBI compliance to criminal justice agencies across the State of Georgia. The group extends the option to receive classroom training or training within an e-Learning environment.

Monthly Update - The Training staff processed 923 emails, 39 crystal reports and managed LMS user account additions. Multiple webinars and one-on-one trainings are being completed to meet State of Georgia training needs.







GEORGIA APPLICANT PROCESSING SERVICE (GAPS) PROJECT

Project Description - The Information Services section of GCIC is seeking to obtain the services of a qualified and experienced vendor to provide an applicant fingerprinting solution that will electronically capture and submit applicant fingerprints to the Automated Fingerprint Identification System (AFIS). The selected vendor will also be responsible for receiving fingerprint search results and disseminating results to the requestor.

Monthly Update - The GBI met with the new third party vendor to discuss the work required for the overall GAPS system.

GEORGIA LAW ENFORCEMENT MESSAGE SWITCH (GLEMS)

Project Description - The message switch provides a means of communication between federal, state, and local law enforcement agencies throughout the state of Georgia, the United States, and other countries, and to take advantage of new features and advances in technology. GCIC is looking to upgrade or replace this system.

Monthly Update - The team meets weekly to review the project and troubleshooting meetings continue until development for the GCIC interfaces is complete. The vendor is working on the completion of testing and configuration of the interfaces.

HUMAN RESOURCE (HR) TIMESHEET PROJECT

Project Description - Enhancement of the application used by non-sworn units of the GBI for tracking time.

Monthly Update - Application development is ongoing. A demonstration of completed requirements is planned within the next few weeks.

RAP BACK PROJECT

Project Description - The Rap Back (RB) project will provide the ability to receive ongoing status notifications of criminal history activity reported on individuals holding positions of trust. Georgia's Rap Back System will include the retention of applicant fingerprints, the implementation of an FBI Rap Back Subscription on such prints, and the creation of a validation process for authorized entities to manage such subscriptions.

Monthly Update - Meetings have taken place with the new third party vendor to discuss next steps.

SERVER REFRESH

Project Description - GBI is working in collaboration with GTA with the replacement, installation and configuration of server hardware replacements and software installs.

Monthly Update - The CCH migration of data (in development) is in progress. GBI is working with Unisys and the CCH vendor on the migration.
