Maintains a secure, reliable, and resilient information technology infrastructure to support GISAC to include: coordinating and implements all components of all LAN systems; managing firewalls; analyzing and managing traffic to detect anomalies, malicious activity, or suspicious file transfer; maintaining secure encrypted remote access; and documenting network configuration. This position will also be responsible for administering GISAC Exchange email server and overseeing the information technology network design and IT planning for GISAC as well serve as the help desk technical support for GISAC staff.
