Re: O.C.G.A. § 10-1-359.5 – Submission of Daily Purchase Transactions

Secondary Metals Recyclers,

O.C.G.A. § 10-1-359.5 was enacted by the Georgia General Assembly in its 2014 session and under this statute Georgia secondary metals recyclers are required to submit daily purchase information to a database that is maintained by the Georgia Bureau of Investigation (GBI). This letter serves as notification to scrap metal processors that this database is now available and you should begin submission of required information to the designated database.

LeadsOnline, the vendor selected to develop and maintain a database on behalf of the GBI, has a registration site that can be accessed at www.leadsonline.com or you may call 800-311-2656. Secondary metals recyclers should register at this site before December 1, 2014. Once registered, a LeadsOnline representative will call within 4 business hours (8:00 a.m. – 6:00 p.m. Eastern Standard Time Monday through Friday) to discuss reporting options and schedule a training session. Please see the enclosed document on "How to Register".
