- Region 13 On July 24, 2024, GBI's Region 13 Perry Field Office arrested and charged Lorenzo Dennard, age 34, of Atkinson County, GA, with 77 counts of Sexual Exploitation of Children, 3 counts of Electronically Furnishing Obscene Material to a Minor, and 1 count of Improper Sexual Contact by an Employee. In June 2024, the Wilcox County Sheriff's Office asked the GBI to investigate allegations that Dennard, a former Wilcox County teacher and coach, had an inappropriate relationship with a former student. Dennard was booked at the Wilcox County Jail and released on bond. This investigation is active and ongoing. Once the investigation is complete, the case file will be given to Crisp County District Attorney's Office for prosecution.
- Southwestern Regional Drug Enforcement Office (SWRDEO) On July 31, 2024, twenty-four (24) people were arrested during Operation Shyne Down in Crisp County, GA. The GBI SWRDEO, the Crisp County Sheriff's Office, the Bureau of Alcohol Tobacco and Firearms (ATF), the Department of Community Supervision (DCS), the GBI Southeastern Regional Drug Enforcement Office, the GBI Middle Georgia Gang Task Force, the GBI Special Operations Unit, the Coffee County Sheriff's Office, the Valdosta Police Department, the Perry Police Department, and the Georgia State Patrol participated in the operation.

This nine-month investigation involved extensive intelligence gathering, undercover investigations, and collaborative efforts amongst the GBI, Crisp County Sheriff's Office, Cordele District Attorney's Office, DCS, and ATF to identify the leadership structure of the G-Shyne Blood Gang in Crisp County, GA. Members of the GBI and other law enforcement agencies served 120 arrest warrants on 24 people in Operation Shyne Down, targeting the criminal street gang G-Shyne Bloods and their involvement in criminal gang activities in Crisp County, GA. Charges include Conspiracy to Sell Marijuana, Sale of Marijuana, Conspiracy to Sell Methamphetamine, Giving False Statements and Writings, Gang Act A, Gang Act B, Gang Act D, Use of a Communication Facility, and RICO. Arrestees were booked into the Crisp County Jail. Additional charges and arrests may follow. This case is active and ongoing. Once the investigation is complete, the case file will be given to the Cordele Judicial Circuit for prosecution.

Office of Special Investigations (OSI) - Cold Case Unit (CCU) – The Coleman-Baker Act (CBA) request webform has been on the GBI website Home page since June 30, 2023. Thirty-one (31) cold cases are being reviewed at this time. Eleven (11) were requests from designated family members and twenty (20) were GBI initiated. CCU has also opened ten (10) GBI cold case unidentified remains (UID) cases in hopes of identifying the victims with FIGG (Forensic Investigative Genetic Genealogy).

• From January 1 to July 31, 2024, the GBI has investigated a total of forty-six (46) Officer Involved Shootings (OIS).

OIS number forty-six (46) was on July 27, 2024. GBI's Region 10 – Atlanta Regional Field Office was requested by the Atlanta Police Department (PD). Atlanta PD officers responded to the 700 block of Peachtree Street in reference to a domestic dispute. Upon arrival, officers met with the caller, who indicated she had been in a physical fight with her partner, Tabiaus Sheely, age 22, of College Park, GA. Officers noticed bruises on the caller's chest and head. The caller asked officers to remove Sheely from her apartment. Responding officers went to the caller's apartment to speak with Sheely. An officer encountered Sheely near the entrance of the apartment building. The officer approached Sheely who fled on foot and shot at the officer. The officer returned fire, striking Sheely in the arm. Sheely was transported to the hospital where he was treated and released into Atlanta PD custody. No officers were injured during the incident.

The GBI will conduct an independent investigation. Once the investigation is complete, it will be given to the Fulton County District Attorney's Office for review.








Backlog Report – YTD FY2024




