



# Investigative Hours Expended YTD FY2022







# PLANS AND PROGRAM DEVELOPMENT

#### **CUSTOMER RELATIONSHIP MANAGEMENT (CRM)**

**Project Description -** The CRM Application Project will provide a single source of historical interaction with external customers and will provide GCIC end users the ability to search, track and report customer interactions throughout business units.


**Monthly Update** - The CJIS Request database was successfully migrated into Microsoft Dynamics.


#### **CUSTOMER SUPPORT & TRAINING**

**Project Description -** The Customer Support Training group provides training in GCIC programs, GCIC applications, and GCIC/FBI compliance to criminal justice agencies across the State of Georgia. The group extends the option to receive classroom training or training within an e-Learning environment.

**Monthly Update -** Training Staff handled 927 emails, eighty-eight phone calls, three crystal reports and managed LMS user account additions. Multiple webinars and one-on-one trainings are being completed to meet State of Georgia training needs.







# GEORGIA APPLICANT PROCESSING SERVICE (GAPS) PROJECT

**Project Description -** The Information Services section of GCIC is seeking to obtain the services of a qualified and experienced vendor to provide an applicant fingerprinting solution that will electronically capture and submit applicant fingerprints to the Automated Fingerprint Identification System (AFIS). The selected vendor shall also handle receiving fingerprint search results and disseminating results to the requestor.

**Monthly Update** - Planning meetings to discuss work required for the overall GAPS system continue.

# GEORGIA LAW ENFORCEMENT MESSAGE SWITCH (GLEMS)

**Project Description -** The message switch provides a means of communication between federal, state, and local law enforcement agencies throughout the state of Georgia, the United States, and other countries, and to take advantage of new features and advances in technology. GCIC is looking to upgrade or replace this system.

**Monthly Update** - Troubleshooting meetings continue. UAT for individual interfaces will start in June.

### HUMAN RESOURCE (HR) TIMESHEET PROJECT

**Project Description** - Enhancement of the application used by non-sworn units of the GBI for tracking time.

**Monthly Update** - The developer presented an informal demonstration to HR and the project team to obtain feedback on the program and requested changes are pending completion. Development work will resume for this project by late June.

### NATIONAL SEX OFFENDER REGISTRY (NSOR) NOTIFICATION PROJECT

**Project Description -** The NSOR project will provide Georgia Department of Early Care and Learning (DECAL) the ability to receive NSOR responses as a part of the criminal history background check, in compliance with Federal, state, and local laws to make complete/accurate fitness determinations.

**Monthly Update** - Meetings to determine next steps are being held. The GBI project team will map out requirements to complete modifications to the GBI system and establish a process for providing NSOR notifications to DECAL.

### RAP BACK PROJECT

**Project Description -** The Rap Back (RB) project will provide the ability to receive ongoing status notifications of criminal history activity reported on individuals holding positions of trust. Georgia's Rap Back System will include the retention of applicant fingerprints, the implementation of an FBI Rap Back Subscription on such prints, and the creation of a validation process for authorized entities to manage such subscriptions.

Monthly Update - Meetings to determine next steps are being held.

### Server Refresh

**Project Description** - GBI is collaborating with GTA with the replacement, installation and configuration of server hardware replacements and software installs.

**Monthly Update** - The CCH migration of data (in development) is in progress and GBI is working with Unisys and the CCH vendor on the migration. The next step is to install the NameSearch feature.
