Director's Highlights

- Region 11 Athens Field Office was requested on February 22, 2024, by the University of Georgia Police Department to assist in a death investigation involving Laken Riley, a 22-year-old female nursing student found deceased on a walking/running trail on UGA's intermural fields. Personnel from GBI's Region 6 Milledgeville, Region 7 Thomson, Region 8 Cleveland, Appalachian Regional Drug Enforcement Office (RDEO), Child Exploitation and Computer Crimes Unit (CEACC), Georgia Cyber Crime Center (G3C), Georgia Information Sharing and Analysis Center (GISAC), Human Exploitation and Trafficking Unit (HEAT), Office of Special Investigations (OSI), and Forensic Artist assisted Region 11 with the investigation with DVR video enhancements, neighborhood canvas, interviews, searches, and other investigative acts. On February 23, 2024, Jose Antonio Ibarra, 26, was arrested and charged with malice and felony murder, aggravated battery, kidnapping, concealing the death of another and several other charges in connection to the death of Laken Riley. GBI's Division of Forensic Sciences Crime Laboratory is processing several pieces of evidence for the investigation. This investigation is still active and ongoing.
- Middle Georgia Gang Task Force On Friday, February 16, 2024, the GBI, Baldwin County Sheriff's Office, Milledgeville Police Department, Georgia College Campus Police Department, and the Georgia Department of Corrections conducted a joint drug investigation in reference to a fraternity house on West Montgomery Street in Milledgeville, GA. Agents had received information that suspected drugs were shipped to the house. After conducting surveillance and other investigative acts, agents executed a search warrant at the house. During the search, agents located a large amount of suspected marijuana, THC Vape cartridges, THC gummies, THC wax, and suspected mushrooms (Psilocybin). Agents also located a small amount of suspected powder cocaine. Drew Charles Courtenay, age 19, of Milledgeville, GA, was arrested and charged with possession of marijuana with the intent to distribute and possession of a Schedule I controlled substance with the intent to distribute. Joseph Michael Lombardi, age 20, of Milledgeville, GA, was arrested and charged with possession of a Schedule I controlled substance. Noah Boyd Petrick, age 21, of Milledgeville, GA, was also arrested and charged with possession of cocaine. All charges are felony offenses. Courtenay, Lombardi, and Petrick were booked into the Baldwin County Jail. The investigation is still active and ongoing. Further arrests are pending. At the conclusion of the investigation, the case will be given to the Ocmulgee District Attorney's Office for prosecution.
- Office of Special Investigations (OSI) Cold Case Unit (CCU) The Coleman-Baker Act (CBA) request
 webform has been on the GBI website Home page since June 30, 2023. Twenty-four (24) cold cases
 are being reviewed at this time. Seven (7) were requests from designated family members and
 seventeen (17) were GBI initiated. CCU has also opened seven (7) GBI cold case unidentified remains
 (UID) cases in hopes of identifying the victims with FIGG (Forensic Investigative Genetic Genealogy).


- From January 1 to February 29, 2024, the GBI investigated a total of ten (10) Officer Involved Shootings (OIS). OIS number ten (10) was on February 23, 2024. GBI's Region 1 Calhoun Field Office was requested by the Rome Police Department. The Rome Police Department received a call in reference to an armed robbery in progress at a convenience store. Surveillance footage shows that Kelvin Gerard Jackson, age 34, of Augusta, GA, entered the store and forced the clerk to place money in a bag at gunpoint. A Rome Police Department officer entered the store and, shortly after, Jackson ran out of the main entrance. The responding officer ran after Jackson. During the encounter, Jackson was shot by the officer. A gun was found next to Jackson. Jackson died in the incident. No officers were injured. The GBI will conduct an independent investigation. Once complete, the case file will be given to the Floyd County District Attorney's Office for review.
- Team GBI participated in the 2024 Polar Plunge at Acworth Beach benefitting Special Olympics Georgia. Team GBI members raised \$16,785, placing third highest team fundraiser for the 2024 plunge at Acworth Beach. Proceeds raised go to help provide free year-round sports training and competition for Special Olympics Georgia's 17,731 athletes.





- Tanja Kopp was promoted to Division of Forensic Sciences Coastal Regional Crime Lab Assistant Manager, effective March 16, 2024.






Investigative Hours Expended - YTD FY2024





Combined DNA Index System (CODIS)



Medical Examiners (includes all laboratories)




