### Director's Highlights

- Child Exploitation and Computer Crimes (CEACC) Unit On Thursday, October 24, 2024, GBI's CEACC Unit arrested and charged two men for sexual exploitation of children. In May 2024, the CEACC Unit initiated two separate proactive investigations into online activity. The investigation of Jonathan Sells, age 39, of Cleveland, White County, GA, led to a search warrant of his home and his subsequent arrest on October 24, 2024. Investigators discovered that Sells both possessed and distributed child sexual abuse material. In addition, Sells was charged with destruction of evidence. The White County Sheriff's Office and Homeland Security Investigations assisted the CEACC Unit with the arrest of Sells. The investigation of Thomas Walker, age 37, of Helen, White County, GA, led to a search warrant of his home and his subsequent arrest on October 24, 2024. Walker was found to be in possession of child sexual abuse material (3 counts). The Helen Police Department assisted the CEACC Unit with the arrest of Walker. Both men were booked at the White County Jail.
- Region 4 On Monday, October 21, 2024, GBI's Region 4 Douglas Field Office was requested by the Atkinson County Sheriff's Office to conduct a death investigation after receiving information about Darion Davis, age 16, of Pearson, GA, dying at a Savannah hospital following an alleged assault that occurred on October 12, 2024. During the investigation, agents discovered a video of a fight in which the suspects were beating Davis. During the fight, a 15-year-old grabbed a pipe and hit Davis multiple times. Several days later, Davis was taken to a hospital, where he died from his injuries. The GBI Medical Examiner's Office in Decatur, GA, completed an autopsy to determine the exact cause and manner of death. On October 29, 2024, the GBI arrested and charged five people in connection to the death of Darion Davis: a fifteen-year-old from Pearson, GA, charged with Malice Murder, Felony Murder, Aggravated Assault, and Aggravated Battery; a fourteen-year-old from Pearson, GA, charged with Felony Murder, Aggravated Assault, and Aggravated Battery; a sixteen-year-old from Pearson, GA, charged with Felony Murder, Aggravated Assault, and Aggravated Battery; Verntron White, age 17, of Pearson, GA, charged with Felony Murder, Aggravated Assault, and Aggravated Battery; and Ta'shunika Jones, age 21, of Pearson, GA, charged with Felony Murder, Aggravated Assault, and Aggravated Battery. They will all be charged as adults. White and Jones were booked into the Atkinson County Jail. The minors are in the custody of the Georgia Department of Juvenile Justice.
- Region 15 On Saturday, October 19, 2024, GBI's Region 15 Sylvester Field Office was requested by Albany State University (ASU) Police Department to investigate a shooting that occurred during the university's homecoming weekend festivities. The ASU Police Department, with the assistance of local and state law enforcement, responded swiftly to the scene. Five people were shot during the incident. One victim, De'Marion Tashawn Daniels, a 19-year-old from Newnan, GA, was killed. Daniels was not an ASU student. The other four victims include: a 13-year-old from Albany, who suffered a gunshot wound; a 17-year-old local high school student, who suffered a gunshot wound; a 16-year-old local high school student, who suffered a gunshot wound; and a 20-year-old who was grazed by a bullet. The injured victims were immediately treated at a triage site on campus before being taken to a local hospital for further care. The campus was placed on lockdown following the shooting, and a search was conducted for the suspect(s). The GBI arrested and charged Jeremy Marshall, age 18, of Albany, GA, with Aggravated Assault (3 counts) and Possession of a Firearm during the Commission of a Felony (3 counts) in connection to the shooting. Marshall is being held at the Dougherty County Jail. The investigation remains active and ongoing.

- Metro Gang Task Force / Region 11 On Sunday, October 13, 2024, GBI's Region 11 Athens Field Office was requested by Elbert County Sheriff's Office to investigate a shooting that occurred late Saturday, October 12, 2024, on Evergreen Drive in Elberton, GA, at a homecoming afterparty that left one minor deceased, and seven others injured. The shooting is believed to be gang related. The GBI Metro Gang Task Force, assisted by the GBI Region 11 office and the Appalachian Regional Drug Enforcement Office, has arrested and charged six people in connection with the shooting death of one victim and the aggravated assault of seven other victims: Jarquavious Scott, age 18, of Anderson, SC, charged with Murder, Aggravated Assault (4 counts), Aggravated Battery, and Violation of the Georgia Street Gang Terrorism and Prevention Act; Destanne Mathis, age 20, of Anderson, SC, charged with Murder, Party to a Crime, and Violation of the Georgia Street Gang Terrorism and Prevention Act; Aanidras Parks, age 18, of Anderson, SC, charged with Murder, Aggravated Assault (4 counts), Aggravated Battery, and Violation of the Georgia Street Gang Terrorism and Prevention Act; Jerimiyah Hughes, age 19, of Anderson, SC, charged with Murder, Aggravated Assault (3 counts), Aggravated Battery, and Violation of the Georgia Street Gang Terrorism and Prevention Act; Desmond Latimer, age 18, of Anderson, SC, charged with Murder, Party to a Crime, and Violation of the Georgia Street Gang Terrorism and Prevention Act; Christopher Bell, age 19, of Anderson, SC, charged with Murder, Aggravated Assault (4 counts), Aggravated Battery, and Violation of the Georgia Street Gang Terrorism and Prevention Act. This investigation is active and ongoing.
- Office of Special Investigations (OSI) Cold Case Unit (CCU) The Coleman-Baker Act (CBA) request
  webform has been on the GBI website Home page since June 30, 2023. Thirty-two (32) cold cases are
  being reviewed at this time. Thirteen (13) were requests from designated family members and
  nineteen (19) were GBI initiated. CCU has also opened twelve (12) GBI cold case unidentified
  remains (UID) cases in hopes of identifying the victims with FIGG (Forensic Investigative Genetic
  Genealogy).
- From January 1 to October 31, 2024, the GBI investigated a total of seventy-four (74) Officer Involved Shootings (OIS). OIS number seventy-four (74) was on October 30, 2024. GBI's Region 10 Atlanta Regional Field Office was requested by the Conyers Police Department. Conyers officers responded to a disturbance call at a Chevron gas station located in Conyers, GA. The 911 caller, who was the store clerk indicated a patron later identified as Jesse Roach, age 40, of Carrollton, GA, had threatened him with a gun. Officers encountered Roach inside the store. As officers were attempting to detain and identify Roach, Roach pushed past them and exited the store. One of the officers attempted to Taser Roach, but Roach was able to remove the Taser probes. Once he removed the probes, Roach pulled a gun from his pocket and shot at the officers. Officers returned fire, hitting and wounding Roach. Roach was taken to Piedmont Rockdale where he was pronounced deceased. Roach's body will be taken to the GBI Medical Examiner's Office for an autopsy. No officers were injured in this incident. The GBI will conduct an independent investigation. Once complete, the case file will be given to the Rockdale County District Attorney's Office for review.



• Conditional offers for employment with the GBI have been made to seventeen (17) Special Agent applicants. The tentative hire date is December 16, 2024.





