

## WHITE FEMALES WITHOUT DNA MATCH - Descriptions of Remains – Walker County

- #44(88A) 35-60 years old, female  
5 ft 2 in to 5 ft 6 in, intermediate build  
no upper teeth, missing lower left wisdom tooth and lower right first molar  
silver fillings lower left first molar, right second premolar, and right second molar  
healing rib fractures – 4 on right & 5 on left  
severe arthritis both shoulders at collar bone  
moderate arthritis left knee and lower back (“stiff back”)  
IV access under skin on upper chest (portacath)  
recent damage/problem with left shoulder muscle (deltoid)  
possibly grey fabric at area of torso  
green and red fabric clothing  
possibly pacemaker  
died Apr 1999-Nov 2000  
does not match any submitted DNA to point of unique identity
- #45B adult, 5 ft 7 in to 5 ft 11 in  
intermediate build  
bowed shins (fibula or smaller lower leg bone) – possibly bow legged  
died Mar 2000-Nov 2000  
does not match any submitted DNA to point of unique identity
- #46A adult, probably female, 5 ft 3 in to 5 ft 7 in  
intermediate build  
old, healed fracture right shoulder – misaligned (shifted backwards)  
possibly healed at an angle or as a bump  
moderate arthritis spine (“stiff back”)  
died Mar 2000-Nov 2000  
does not match any submitted DNA to point of unique identity
- #55 brown fine hair  
autopsied  
died Mar 1998- Mar 2000  
does not match any submitted DNA to point of unique identity
- #56A older adult  
missing all right lower molars and first right lower premolar, missing all left lower teeth  
missing central lower teeth – only right lower eyetooth and first premolar remain

- #82A female with extreme arthritis in right ankle  
died May 1998-Jun 1999

thin build  
missing all wisdom teeth and one additional molar upper and lower on both sides  
porcelain crowns on right upper second molar and first premolar  
porcelain crowns on all upper central teeth to left upper first molar  
porcelain crowns on left lower first molar and both left lower premolars

- 4 tooth bridge w/ porcelain crowns right lower premolars and first & second molars  
plastic fillings on all 4 lower front (central) teeth  
arthritis in spine with fused neck vertebra and all spine (“stiff”)

- #85A over 60 years, female, 5 ft 2 in to 5 ft 8 in, heavy set  
arthritis shoulder, elbow, and hip

significant arthritis spine (“stiff”)  
missing all molars (all three back teeth on both sides, top and bottom)  
root canal right upper outside front tooth (7)  
silver fillings both right upper premolars and left upper first premolar  
silver fillings both right lower premolars  
plastic fillings right and left upper canines (eyetooth)  
plastic fillings both left lower premolars and right lower second premolar  
porcelain crowns all four upper front center teeth (7-10)  
porcelain crown left lower second premolar  
pink dress  
white half slip  
light colored bra, regular  
pink jacket, lace  
bedroom slippers, fuzzy tiger design  
light color panties  
pink belt  
pillow with pillowcase  
possibly embalmed  
died Nov 1999-Dec 2000  
does not match any submitted DNA
- #103 over 55 years, possibly white, female, 5 ft to 5 ft 6 in, medium build  
missing all teeth  
probably died in hospital  
bony abnormality with possible deformity/angularity right shoulder  
multiple collapsed vertebra – had lost significant height (become shorter)  
arthritis both knees, spine, and pelvis (“stiff”)  
right hip replacement  
possible abnormal shape or deformity/size in right chest  
possibly unusual shape to ribs on both sides  
died Apr 1998-Dec 1999  
does not match any submitted DNA to point of unique identity
- #104 over 60 years, possibly white, possibly female  
TMJ/jaw/”back tooth” problems  
midline hard palate with bony knob  
missing all four wisdom teeth

missing all left upper teeth from canine (eyetooth) back

possibly broken off right upper outer center (front) tooth

bird design, silver/grey metal ring with red-brown stone

teal skirt  
died Sept – Nov 00 or June – Sept 01  
does not match any submitted DNA to point of unique identity
- #144 over 50 years, white, probably female, 5 ft 4 in to 5 ft 7 in, small frame  
missing all teeth  
squared chin  
nose significantly deviated to right (possibly old fracture)  
moderate arthritis both knees, both elbows, and left shoulder  
extreme arthritis right ankle and foot – likely old injury  
slight arthritis spine (mildly “stiff”)  
significant prior trauma – possibly car wreck  
    old healed fracture left second rib  
    old healed fracture right arm at or near wrist  
    old healed fracture left arm at or near wrist  
    old healed fracture both sides pelvis in front (pubic ramus)  
golden chain necklace  
“Sonic” peppermint candy wrappers  
light color blouse with lace trim at cuffs  
white slip  
black stretch pants, large size , “New York Style” brand  
single white stocking, possibly for medical purposes (prevent clots)  
light color panties, large size  
died Apr 1998-Dec 1999  
does not match any submitted DNA to point of unique identity

coarse, straight, red hair  
missing all upper teeth  
missing all three lower molars on both sides and right lower second premolar  
long fingernails with copper colored nail polish  
breast bone curved to front  
moderate arthritis both hips and lower spine  
autopsied  
light color dress with six green buttons, lace present  
white pantyhose (two)  
white slip  
white bra (big)  
white panties  
died Apr 1999-May 2000  
does not match any submitted DNA to point of unique identity
- #179 adult white female, 4 ft 10 in  
medium light brown hair  
missing all teeth  
embalmed  
light color, long sleeve, flower print (red, purple, and yellow), with white lace collar  
light briefs, large size  
light color slip, size 36  
died Apr 1999-May 2000  
does not match any submitted DNA to point of unique identity
- #192 over 50 years, female, small build  
probably died in hospital or nursing home  
hospital gown  
light color sock  
old healed fracture left upper arm, didn't set straight (arm might be crooked or have bony knot)  
moderate arthritis of backbone – “stiff” back  
Died May 2001-Oct 2001  
does not match any submitted DNA
- #193 45-65 years, white, 5 ft 4 in to 5ft 11 in  
long grey or dark blonde hair  
bony nodule on hard palate in mouth  
missing all three right upper molars and right upper first premolar  
missing right upper outer front tooth  
missing left upper eyetooth, both left upper premolars, and left upper second and third molars  
Died May 2001-Oct 2001  
does not match any submitted DNA
- #194 middle aged to older adult, female, 5 ft to 5 ft 4 in, small build  
osteoporosis  
probably died in nursing home or hospital  
partially healed right rib fracture in front (weeks to months prior to death)

died May-Oct 201  
does not match any submitted DNA to point of unique identity
- #225 18-35 years, white female, 5 ft 3 in, medium build  
missing *at least* right upper and lower and left upper wisdom teeth  
missing right and left upper second premolars  
teeth in very good condition with few or no fillings at all  
no major bone disease or trauma  
died Nov 1999-Dec 2000  
does not match any submitted DNA to point of unique identity
- #229 over 60 years, white female, 5 ft 4 in to 5 ft 8 in, small frame  
probably died in hospital or nursing home  
illegible ID band  
old, healed left mastectomy (left breast cancer, breast removed)  
osteoporosis  
short to medium straight, grey hair  
missing all teeth with upper and lower denture plates in place  
flower print dress  
size 44 bra, “Exclusively Yours” brand, with filler in left cup area  
panties  
pair socks  
died Nov 1999-Dec 2000  
does not match any submitted DNA to point of unique identity

missing *at least* right upper and right lower wisdom teeth  
silver fillings *at least* left upper first premolar and left upper first molar  
plastic fillings left upper outside front tooth, left upper eyetooth, and right upper first premolar  
porcelain crown *at least* left upper second premolar  
metal crowns *at least* left upper second molar and right lower second premolar  
metal crown right lower first and second molars  
died Jan 98-Mar 99  
does not match any submitted DNA
- #310 over 35 years, white female, 5 ft to 5 ft 4 in, small frame  
missing *at least* all upper teeth on left side, left lower teeth from eyetooth back, and all three right lower molars  
old, healed fractures left second and third ribs  
arthritis lower spine  
light color nightshirt  
died Jun-Sep 2001  
does not match any submitted DNA
- #312 over 45 years, 5 ft 3 in to 5 ft 6 in  
old fracture left collar bone, healed crooked – possible bump on collarbone  
old fracture right upper arm, healed crooked – possible bony knob or bend in bone  
old bone infection right upper arm  
artificial right hip  
died Jun-Sep 2001

cast or splint with elastic bandage wrap on right forearm  
twisted spine – leaned to his left side (kyphoscoliosis)  
possible right mastectomy (right breast cancer – removed)  
some arthritis backbone  
metal surgical clips in right chest area (possible mastectomy)  
few metal surgical clips in abdomen (gall bladder or hysterectomy)  
missing all upper teeth  
missing both left lower premolars and all three left lower molars  
missing both right lower premolars and all three right lower molars  
plastic filling left lower outer front tooth  
porcelain crown right lower eyetooth  
died Jun-Sep 2001  
does not match any submitted DNA
- #334 adult white female, 4 ft 7 in to 4 ft 9 in  
medium length grey hair  
died in hospital or nursing home  
missing all teeth  
arthritis in backbone – “stiff” back  
old, healed left thigh fracture with metal plate and six screws (five same length)  
feeding tube into stomach through the abdominal wall  
hospital gown  
died Jan 1998-Dec 2001  
does not match any submitted DNA to point of unique identity
- #336 adult female  
missing all teeth  
medium length dark blonde-brown hair  
right mastectomy (right breast cancer removed)  
died in hospital or nursing home “Angelica Healthcare” – sheet with body  
absorbent pad under body  
died Jan 1998-Dec 2001  
does not match any submitted DNA
- #338 older adult, white female, 4 ft 9 in  
medium length grey hair  
probably died in nursing home (possibly hospital)  
blue and white patterned gown  
missing all four wisdom teeth  
missing left lower second molar and right lower eyetooth through first molar  
silver filling left upper second molar  
gold fillings right upper first and second molars  
porcelain crowns right upper eyetooth and both right upper front teeth  
porcelain crowns left upper outer front tooth and left upper eyetooth  
porcelain crown left lower first premolar  
gold crowns both right upper premolars and left upper first molar
