

**WHITE FEMALES NO DNA MATCH POSSIBLE**  
**Descriptions of Remains – Walker County**

- #39 older adult, over 50 years, probably white, probably female, 5 ft 3 in to 5 ft 9 in  
missing all teeth (no upper or lower teeth)  
possible healed fracture middle left forearm  
old fracture left thigh with metal plate (5 screws)  
green patterned nylon pullover shirt, size 40/20W, “Anytime” brand  
severe arthritis with fused vertebra in neck and middle-lower back (“stiff”)  
died May 1998 – Mar 1999  
NO DNA MATCH POSSIBLE
- #47 30-55 years, 5 ft to 5 ft 2 in, small build  
missing all wisdom teeth except right lower  
missing left upper second molar and right upper first molar  
missing right upper outside front tooth  
silver fillings left upper first molar, left lower second molar, & right lower first molar  
mild arthritis right knee  
stiff neck (2 fused vertebrae in middle)  
died May 1998-June 1999  
NO DNA MATCH POSSIBLE
- #48 45-65 years, female, 5 ft 1 in to 5 ft 6 in, small build  
died May 1998-June 1999  
NO DNA MATCH POSSIBLE
- #56A older adult  
missing all right lower molars and first right lower premolar, missing all left lower teeth  
missing central lower teeth – only right lower eyetooth and first premolar remain

- #61A adult female  
missing left lower molar and left lower second premolar  
porcelain crown left lower first molar  
silver filling left lower canine (eye tooth)  
died Nov 1999-Dec 2000  
NO DNA MATCH POSSIBLE
- #61B adult  
impacted, unerupted right lower eyetooth  
missing right lower second molar and wisdom tooth  
missing right lower first premolar  
died Nov 1999-Dec 2000  
NO DNA MATCH POSSIBLE
- #82A female with extreme arthritis in right ankle  
died May 1998-June 1999

- #88 elderly, over 60 years, female, about 5 ft 3 in  
missing all teeth  
osteoporosis

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- red & green print house dress  
white full slip  
panties  
possibly wore pacemaker  
died Apr 1999-May 2000  
NO DNA MATCH POSSIBLE
- #101 elderly adult, white (possibly black)  
right back side skull surgery, weeks to months before death (healing) with wire & screws  
(parieto-occipital craniotomy)  
four upper vertebra collapsed – had lost significant height (became shorter)  
arthritis toe  
plastic filling right upper first premolar  
died July 1998-July 2000  
NO DNA MATCH POSSIBLE
- #123 over 55 years, female, 5 ft 2 in to 5 ft 5 in, small frame  
brown hair  
missing all teeth  
osteoporosis  
abdominal surgery with metal clips, possibly hysterectomy  
left thigh fracture at hip, metal plate put in with severe infection  
mild arthritis back  
possibly eye donor  
two white indwelling tubes (stents)  
light color shirt, petite size, “Michelle Stewart” brand  
nylon slip, size 36, “Bradley” brand  
green skirt, petite 2 size  
bird design, silver/grey metal ring with red-brown stone  
teal jacket  
teal skirt  
died Sept-Nov 2000 or Jun-Sept 2001  
does not match any submitted DNA to point of unique identity
- #146 middle aged to older adult, female  
missing lower wisdom teeth  
silver fillings right and left lower first molars  
bony nodules on inside jawbone, protruding into mouth  
died May 1998-Jun 1999  
NO DNA MATCH POSSIBLE
- #148B adult female, 5 ft 2 in to 5 ft 6 in, medium build  
healed fracture inner right collarbone  
died Apr 1998-Dec 1999  
NO DNA MATCH POSSIBLE
- #158 older adult, probably female, 5 ft 3 in to 5 ft 6 in  
missing all lower teeth  
healing fracture both bones of left ankle (weeks to months prior to death)

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arthritis left hip and left knee  
died May 1998-Jun 1999  
NO DNA MATCH POSSIBLE

- #299 over 50 years, female with small build  
arthritis right hand  
collapsed vertebrae in back – had lost height (became shorter)  
had white tube either from head to belly or into vein  
died Jan 98 – Mar 99  
NO DNA MATCH POSSIBLE
- #340 lower denture plate only held in by right lower back teeth  
“partial lower roundhouse bridge #18-32 Supported by blade implant #29-31”  
NO DNA MATCH POSSIBLE
- #341 upper denture plate held in by both eyeteeth  
only upper eyeteeth remain in place  
lower denture plate held in place by both lower eyeteeth and both lower first molars  
both lower eyeteeth and both lower first molars remain in place  
NO DNA MATCH POSSIBLE
- #2006 adult, medium build  
old fracture, left arm above wrist, healed at angle (possible bend or bony knot)  
NO DNA MATCH POSSIBLE  
Unknown date of death
- #2034 adult, possible female, 4 ft 8 in to 5 ft, small frame  
old fracture right forearm, healed at angle – possible bony knot or bent  
died Jan-July 2000  
NO DNA MATCH POSSIBLE
- #2036 adult, possible female, medium build  
missing all lower teeth – possibly tooth extracted within 6 months prior to death  
died Jan-July 2000  
**UNKNOWN DNA STATUS**
- #2038 adult  
missing all three upper molars on both sides  
missing right upper second premolar, right outer upper front tooth, and left outer upper front tooth  
plastic fillings right upper center front tooth and left upper eyetooth  
partial upper denture plate –  
right 1<sup>st</sup> molar, right 2<sup>nd</sup> premolar, right center front tooth, left outer front tooth, left 1<sup>st</sup> molar, and 2<sup>nd</sup> molar  
died Jan-July 2000
